Again, I found the report very helpful. I am looking forward to distributing the final version to staff and the Board.

I had no idea we were so productive compared to the rest of the country!

Here's a list of the fairly minor factual corrections needed, by page:

pp. 2-3, the census data you report with ethnic populations adds up to 109%. I am not sure what the right answer is.
p. 3 - the farm/ranch hotline and rural response hotlines are managed and supervised separately from the AccessLine(R).
p. 4 - second full paragraph, the needs assessment was completed and published in 2007, not 2006.
p. 6, first full para. LAN has 2 staff who are fluent in Mandarin Chinese, in addition to what you have written.
p. 7, first full para. "YouTube" is one word.
p. 8, various, again, farm/ranch is separate from the AccessLine(R).
p. 11, third paragraph. The migrant unit attorney is an "experienced attorney," but is not fluent in Spanish. The migrant unit outreach coordinator is "a native Spanish speaker," but is not an attorney. Two separate people.
p. 15, middle paragraph, should reflect that the ED's evaluation "was completed in December 2009."
