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2 proposals for funding. Where we're at at this point  
3 with regard to the remaining four proposals is, we're  
4 exploring with them the possibility of coming up with a  
5 match. One of the reasons Mr. Dalstrom's proposal was so  
6 attractive to us is, he came to us initially with a match.  
7 I seem to recall it was almost a dollar for dollar match.  
8 So with response to that particular observation by Mr.  
9 Dalstrom that our failure to award that money would  
10 indicate somehow or another a lessening of our commitment  
11 to the Native American community, I just wanted to indicate  
12 for the record that we have moved with regard to those  
13 grant monies, and as I say, have awarded one of the grants  
14 and intend to award the other four.

15 MR. VALOIS: Thank you, Mr.  
16 Brooks. Mrs. Norris, I don't want to get into a blow by  
17 blow exchange about letters which are not in the record  
18 and so forth. I think you have the Corporation's commitment

19 MRS. NORRIS: I just wanted  
20 to clarify that the problems with the matching funds was  
21 not part of the initial RFP request for proposal.

22 MR. VALOIS: Mrs. Swafford,  
23 you had a motion?

24 MRS. SWAFFORD: Yes, I do  
25 have a motion. I move that the Board of Directors  
authorize the president of the Corporation to consolidate

2 regional office functions within headquarters and make  
3 the necessary personnel and operational changes to effec-

5 MR. VALOIS: Is there a

9 MRS. BERNSTEIN: Hortencia  
10 seconds it.

11 MR. VALOIS: We have two  
12 seconds, thank you. Is there any further discussion  
13 concerning this motion?

14 MR. SMEGAL: I did want to  
15 follow up on...a comment was made that isn't clear to me  
16 from the materials that I was provided by Mary that we're  
17 talking about the same thing. There are six applications  
18 that have been in there for a long time. You had a  
19 September, 1985 Federal Register pronouncement of money  
20 available.

21 Her concern and my understanding is that there's some  
22 condition subsequent to come along here now, and unless  
23 the applicant comes up with some mechanism for reaching  
24 out and getting some matching funds, they're not going to  
25 get their application approved. Is that inconsistent  
with what you all are doing? I understand one grant, and
