Reg. 44,398, Applicants must have submitted a Notice of Intent to Compete accepted by LSC in order to submit a proposal in response to this RFP and participate in the grant competition.
Geographic Scope of Services: An application must include a plan to serve eligible veterans, dependents, or other persons with proceedings before the Court, <i>regardless of their location or residence</i> . An application may not be restricted to service in a particular geographic area or otherwise exclude eligible persons. To provide the required coverage, an Applicant may partner with other organizations.
