RESOLUTION OF THE LEGAL SERVICES CORPORATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS REGARDING CERTAIN EVICTION PROCEEDINGS

WHEREAS, the drug problem in our country has had a devastating effect on the poor in America, especially those who live in public housing; and

WHEREAS, resources available to legal services programs are limited and as such should be used in the most productive manner.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Board of the Corporation directs the staff of the Corporation to develop a regulation in a form appropriate for adoption by the Board that prohibits the use of LSC funds to represent a person in a proceeding to evict such person from a public housing project if the person has been convicted of or is being prosecuted for the illegal sale or distribution of a controlled substance and if the eviction proceeding is brought by a public housing agency on the basis that the illegal drug activity of such person threatens the health or safety of other tenants residing in the public housing project or employees of the public housing agency.
