

Request for Letters of Intent for 2010 Grant Funding

TIG 2010 Letters of Intent

- Since 2000, TIG has made 413 grants totalling \$33 million
- Projects to develop, test and replicate innovative technologies
- Improve clients' access to high quality legal assistance through an integrated and well managed technology system

TIG 2010 Letters of Intent Eligibility

- Only LSC program grantees are eligible to apply for TIG funds. Other entities are encouraged to participate as project partners.
- Programs should be up to date on all previous TIG grants prior to submitting a LOI.

TIG 2010 Funding

- Approximately \$3.4 million will be available for 2010 grant awards
- Additional funds may be available from the State Justice Institute for projects that include collaboration with local and state courts. See <u>www.statejustice.org</u> for more information.

- LSC will accept projects in three application categories for 2010:
 - Website
 - Replication
 - Open Category

Websites

- Renewal Websites \$25,000 max
- Continuation Websites \$25,000 max
- Website Improvement & Innovation (new)
 - Initiatives to expand the use of websites
 - Add new tools, promote traffic, build community and increase effectiveness to better serve the community, partners, advocates and client population

- Replication to implement tested methodologies and technologies from previous TIG projects
 - A: Replication of Previous TIG Projects look at projects where software or content has been created and available
 - B: Automated Form Replication identify Hot Docs and A2J templates on LawHelp Interactive National HotDocs Server that can be replicated for your jurisdiction at a cost savings

- Open Category designated for projects that
 - Implement new or innovative approaches for using technology in legal services;
 - Enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of other TIG initiatives; and/or
 - Enable grantees to substantially increase and/or improve services provided to their client communities
 - Proposals that would have broad applicability and/or impact are strongly encouraged

TIG 2010 Areas of Interest

- 4 Areas of Interest Encouraged:
 - Board Training and Oversight
 - Changing Service Demands Caused by the Economic Crisis
 - Increasing Access to Legal Assistance for Limited English Proficient Client Populations
 - Improving Fiscal Operations

TIG 2010 LOI Requirements

- One Project per Letter of Intent; applicants may submit multiple LOIs
- Submit online at <u>http://tig.lsc.gov</u> under the TIG Online Systems tab (available by February 1, 2010
- Reminder: Programs should be up to date according to the milestone schedule on all previous TIG grants prior to submitting a LOI.

TIG 2010 Timeline

- February 1: LOI Online System Available
- February 19: Letters of Intent Due
- March 19: LSC notifies successful LOI applicants
- May 7: Full applications Due
- September: LSC notifies successful applicants of grant awards
